

Request for Statement of Interest (SOI)
Kane County Division of Transportation (KDOT) Building A
Air Conditioning System Replacement

The Kane County Division of Transportation (KDOT) is in need of professional services from a qualified engineering firm to provide design and final contract preparation for the replacement of the Air Conditioning System for Building A located on our campus at 41W011 Burlington Road, St. Charles, IL 60175. The attached Project Description provides a summary of major items that will be encountered during the work. At this time, the County anticipates issuing the Notice to Proceed in February/March 2018, with a contract duration of approximately 24 months.

The Statement of Interest shall be submitted electronically via KDOT QBS no later than 4:00 pm on Friday, October 13, 2017. If you plan to enter into a joint venture with another firm for this project please note this on your Statement of Interest, including the name of the firm you are entering into a joint venture with for this project. The County plans to request proposals and conduct phone interviews with the short-listed firms. Firms interested in providing services to Kane County are hereby notified of the Kane County's Ethics Ordinance No. 10-206, in particular, Section 10, page 15. Only the firm that is ultimately selected for these professional services will be required to provide the Ethic Ordinance information directly to the Kane County Division of Transportation as part of the consultant services agreement. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The work will consist of on-site evaluation and research of the existing system, the engineering and design of the new system, as well as preparation of the necessary final contract plans and bid documents, along with a pre-final and final cost estimate for the complete removal and replacement of the Air Conditioning System in Building A. The new system shall be designed to meet and comply with all current HVAC refrigerant standards and regulations.
