The prequalification document will be reviewed and approved in a short period of time if the appropriate documentation was provided. Each firm must first be prequalified in order to electronically submit their Statement of Interest via KDOT QBS no later than the deadline described above.

## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The Kane County Division of Transportation was awarded approximately \$1,000,000 in Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funding for improvements to Orchard Road and Fabyan Parkway. On Orchard Road, from south of Jericho Road to north of Route 30, the safety improvements will consist of the installation of flashing yellow arrows at intersections and wet reflective pavement markings. For Fabyan Parkway, at Route 31, the work consists of the placement of signal heads at the center of each lane, yellow flashing arrow, the installation of advanced warning flashers with a wig-wag light and the installation of a dilemma zone detection system at the intersection.

The abbreviated phase I and complete phase II services will be locally funded, but utilize the federal aid process as phase III is federally funded. The project will be completed under applicable IDOT guidelines, including the BLR and BDE manuals, as well as KDOT standards.

The **Scope** includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Detailed surveys, as necessary, for the planning and design of the project
- Analysis of crash data and review of any available speed studies
- PESA and PSI
- Soil/pavement investigations, as necessary, to determine roadway section and structural design
- Complete all necessary (Phase I) Categorical Exclusion Group I (CE I) documentation and associated environmental compliance reports
- Estimate of construction cost
- Obtain clearances (and permits) from all regulatory agencies as required by the scope of the proposed improvements
- Submit and coordinate all necessary permit requests for any work required outside Kane County right of way
- Coordinate with Kane County, municipalities, and other involved parties/agencies as necessary
- Preparation of preliminary, pre-final and final plans.
