PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Kane County Division of Transportation is undertaking a feasibility study to examine potential improvements to the interchange at Randall Road and I90. The effort will include work to address geometric and capacity deficiencies for traffic entering and exiting I90, as well as through traffic on Randall Road. Various alternatives will be considered. The study effort shall include external coordination (agency, municipality and utility) and outreach.

At the County's discretion, the selected consultant for the feasibility study may be retained for potential future engineering phases.

Future design engineering phases will utilize the federal aid process. The project will be completed under applicable IDOT and ISTHA guidelines, including the BLR and BDE manuals, as well as KDOT standards.
