

Request for Statement of Interest (SOI)
Kane County Division of Transportation (KDOT)
Randall Road at IL Route 72 Intersection Improvements (Sec. 19-00514-00-WR)

The Kane County Division of Transportation is in need of professional services from a qualified engineering consultant firm to provide Phase I and Phase II Design Engineering Services for intersection improvements at Randall Road and IL Route 72.

The attached **Project Description** provides a summary of major items that are likely to be encountered during the course of the Phase I and II services required. If the consultant selected successfully completes the Phase I services, at the County's sole discretion, the County may seek to immediately negotiate a Phase II agreement for such work, thereby eliminating a Phase II QBS process.

At this time, the County anticipates starting this work in the Fall of 2019 with a duration of approximately eighteen (18) to twenty-four (24) months to complete the work.

The 2–page Statement of Interest document shall be submitted electronically via KDOT QBS no later than 2:00 pm on May 31, 2019. If you plan to enter into a joint venture with another firm for this project please note this on your Statement of Interest, including the name of the firm you are entering into a joint venture with for this project. The Short-listed firms will be posted on our Consultant Selection Summary Table website at <http://www.co.kane.il.us/dot/SOISummary.aspx>.

Any new firm interested in doing work with the Kane County in regards to this or any other future professional service, must first submit their Prequalification Document to Kane County by following the instructions found at <http://kdot.countyofkane.org/Shared%20Documents/QBS.pdf>. The prequalification document will be reviewed and approved in a short period of time if the appropriate documentation was provided. Each firm must first be prequalified in order to electronically submit their Statement of Interest via KDOT QBS no later than the deadline described above.

Firms interested in providing services to Kane County are hereby notified of the Kane County's Ethics Ordinance No. 10-206, in particular, Section 10, page 15. Only the firm that is ultimately selected for these professional services will be required to provide the Ethic Ordinance information directly to the Kane County Division of Transportation as part of the consultant services agreement. A Statement of Interest (SOI) received after the above noted deadline will not be used as part of our consultant selection process.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Kane County Division of Transportation is looking to provide improvements to the intersection of Randall Road and IL Route 72. The work includes additional lanes on Randall Road and any other improvements deemed necessary as part of the Phase I studies. All Phase I and Phase II work shall follow the same process and guidelines as the Federal Aid process. This project will be completed under applicable IDOT guidelines including BLRS and BDE manuals, and KDOT standards.

The Consultant will provide Phase I engineering services, which includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Detailed topographic surveys, as necessary, for the planning and design of the project
- Preparation of traffic studies, analysis of crash data, and any special intersection studies that may be required to furnish data for the design of the proposed improvement
- An Intersection Design Study will be required
- Soil/pavement investigations, as necessary, to determine roadway structural design, as well as CCDD screening
- Environmental planning documents
- Wetland Delineation, as necessary
- Location Drainage Study
- Project Development Report (PDR)
- Estimate of construction costs
- ADA improvements, as necessary
- Preparation of preliminary roadway plans
- Assistance obtaining clearances (and permits) from all regulatory agencies as required by the scope of the proposed improvements
- Submit and coordinate all necessary permit requests for any work required
- Obtaining Design Approval from the Illinois Department of Transportation
- Coordinate with KDOT, IDOT and other involved parties/agencies as necessary

The Consultant will provide Phase II engineering services, which includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Preparation of detailed plans, specifications, cost estimate and other documents and exhibits necessary for the project
- Preparation of Contract Proposal, all necessary bidding documents and post-letting plan revisions and/or post-design services
- Environmental updates and/or required documents
- Geotechnical investigations, as necessary
- Drainage Design
- Traffic signal and timing design
- Secure all necessary clearances and permits (K/DSWCD, Kane County Stormwater Ordinance, etc.)
- Coordination with all utilities impacted by the project to ensure relocation is accomplished
- Submit and coordinate all necessary permit requests for any work required
- Coordination with IDOT and other involved stakeholder parties/agencies as necessary.
