

Request for Statement of Interest (SOI)
Kane County Division of Transportation (KDOT)
Randall Road at Hopps Road Intersection Improvement (Sec. 19-00511-00-CH)

The Kane County Division of Transportation is in need of professional services from a qualified consultant to provide design engineering services. The project consists of intersection improvements to Randall Road at Hopps Road.

The 2–page Statement of Interest document shall be submitted electronically via KDOT QBS no later than 4:00 pm on July 17, 2019. If you plan to enter into a joint venture with another firm for this project please note this on your Statement of Interest, including the name of the firm you are entering into a joint venture with for this project. The Short-listed firms will be posted on our Consultant Selection Summary Table website at <http://www.co.kane.il.us/dot/SOISummary.aspx>.

Any new firm interested in doing work with the Kane County in regards to this or any other future professional service, must first submit their Prequalification Document to Kane County by following the instructions found at <http://kdot.countyofkane.org/Shared%20Documents/QBS.pdf>. The prequalification document will be reviewed and approved in a short period of time if the appropriate documentation was provided. Each firm must first be prequalified in order to electronically submit their Statement of Interest via KDOT QBS no later than the deadline described above.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Kane County Division of Transportation is undertaking the design of improvements to the intersection of Randall Road at Hopps Road. The effort will include a complete phase I study to address geometric deficiencies, including considering intersection realignment, as well as work to increase capacity and storage at the intersection. The limits on Randall Road will be from Gyorr Avenue to 2100' north of Hopps Road.

The study shall have a draft project development report completed by April of 2021.

At the County's discretion, the selected consultant for the phase I study may be retained for the following phase II design effort.

The phase I and phase II design process will utilize the federal aid process. The phase I engineering contract will be locally funded. The project will be completed under applicable IDOT guidelines, including the BLR and BDE manuals, as well as KDOT standards.
