## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The Kane County Division of Transportation will provide improvements to the intersection of Randall Road and Big Timber Road. This work will consider capacity improvements on all legs and bicycle/pedestrian accommodations. The northern limit on Randall Road will be coordinated with future Randall Road/I90 improvements. The south limit will be to be the Claude Hanson bridge (Randall Road over the U.P., Tyler Creek, U.P. RR and Metra).

The phase I shall have a draft project development report completed by April of 2021.

At the County's discretion, the selected consultant for the phase I study may be retained for the following phase II design effort.

The phase I and phase II design process will utilize the federal aid process. The phase I engineering contract will be locally funded. The project will be completed under applicable IDOT guidelines, including the BLR and BDE manuals, as well as KDOT standards.
