The Kane County Division of Transportation is in need of professional services from a qualified consultant to provide design-engineering services. The project consists of a feasibility to consider improvements to the intersection of Randall Road and Route 20.

If you plan to enter into a joint venture with another firm for this project please note this on your Statement of Interest, including the name of the firm you are entering into a joint venture with for this project. Any new firm interested in doing work with the Kane County in regards to this or any other future professional service, must first submit their Prequalification Document to Kane County by following the instructions found at http://kdot.countyofkane.org/Shared%20Documents/QBS.pdf. The prequalification document will be reviewed and approved in a short period of time if the appropriate documentation was provided. Each firm must first be prequalified in order to electronically submit their Statement of Interest via KDOT QBS no later than the deadline described above.

Only the firm that is ultimately selected for these professional services will be required to provide the Ethic Ordinance information directly to the Kane County Division of Transportation as part of the consultant services agreement. A Statement of Interest (SOI) received after the above noted deadline will not be used as part of our consultant selection process.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Kane County Division of Transportation is undertaking a feasibility study for the reconstruction of the Randall Road at U.S. Route 20 interchange. The effort will include work to address geometric deficiencies as well as to increase capacity at the interchange.

The initial phase of the work, the scope of work that will be considered under this request for statements of interest, will be a feasibility study to examine various alternatives for improvements to the existing intersection. These alternatives may be further defined within a subsequent phase I engineering study. The feasibility study will include extensive coordination such as with the Illinois Department of Transportation (due to Route 20) and the City of Elgin, public outreach, and, external coordination regarding historical properties and 4f/6f considerations (if necessary).

Given the proximity of various local roads such as Larkin Avenue, Weld Road and Foothill Road, the study will also consider impacts to those facilities.

At the County's discretion, the selected consultant for the feasibility study may be retained for the following phase I and phase II design effort, if those efforts proceed.

The feasibility, preliminary and final design will utilize the federal aid process. The project will be completed under applicable IDOT guidelines, including the BLR and BDE manuals, as well as KDOT standards.
